Table 5. Example of objectives-actions matrix. The letters in the table represent selected counter-measures, actions or schemes to be selected upon consultation with relevant stakeholders.

Table 6. Example of pay-off matrix: the outcome of the intervention is ranked against the control which is 'do nothing', so 'LOW' means that the intervention package has not improved the situation and helped attain the 'OBJECTIVE'. Individual 'ACTIONS' rather than 'INTERVENTION PACKAGES' may also be evaluated in this manner.
